## 6-Year Anniversary of "On the Record" Public Meeting Video Project!

## Calaveras County Board of Supervisors, Planning Commission, CCWD, & Other Public Meeting **Videos Available on Community Action Project Website**

VALLEY SPRINGS, CA--MyValleySprings.com (MVS) announces the milestone 6-year anniversary of our county government meetings video project, "On the Record" (OTR). OTR began with the taping of Calaveras County Planning Commission meetings in February 2009, and is an ongoing collaborative project to make county supervisor, water agency, and planning meetings available to the public. Videos of Board of Supervisors, Planning Commission, Calaveras County Water District Board, and other public meetings are available on the Community Action Project (CAP) website, www.calaverascap.com. Meetings are archived back to the Planning Commission in 2009 and the Board of Supervisors starting in 2011. Other agency and planning videos are posted on the MVS "On the Record" video page, www.myvalleysprings.com/video.

Each new meeting video is normally posted within a day of the meeting and a complete archive of meetings can be accessed on the site. Planning Commission meetings are also available at the public library. Preparation, posting, and archiving of meeting videos is made possible through a partnership between the non-profit community organizations CAP and MVS, which promote public participation in local government and land use planning. Videos are also provided courtesy of Calaveras Public Access Television.

Citizens who are not able to attend meetings are able to view meeting videos at their convenience. A January public forum, "Let's Talk About Why the General Plan Matters", is now posted for the benefit of all citizens of Calaveras County. Making videos easily accessible helps hold elected officials accountable and fosters county decision-making that is open and transparent. The videos are an invaluable record of past discussions that inform the future.

Current and archived videos are easily located, by date, from the "Video" box at the top of the CAP website home page, <u>www.calaverascap.com</u>.
