## CCWD presents rate hike reasons to its customers

Calaveras County Water District ratepayers had an opportunity to hear reasons for the district's proposed water and wastewater rate increases and voice their opinions on the issue at a series of community workshops last week.

Those meetings were held in Arnold, Copperopolis and Valley Springs.

If approved, the proposed five-year schedule of water and wastewater rate increases would be implemented Oct. 16. The proposal, for the first year, calls for a (See Page 2)
